Beschreibung

Regarding the uncontrolled migration towards the EU, the Member States decided to establish the Agency Frontex, which should help them to better control migration at the land and sea borders. Since its establishment, the Agency experienced an immense increase in monetary and human capital but was also increasingly confronted with accusations regarding human rights violations, as well as the ongoing securitization and militarization of the EU borders.

This paper aims to analyse the historical background and development of Frontex, as well as the applied methods within its joint operations. It will take into account the linguistic framework established through the methods used in the training facilities of the Agency, will raise the question about the accountability of Frontex and the Member States regarding human rights violations and aims to analyse how the ongoing securitization and militarization of the borders is compatible with the growing humanitarian approach within the Agency.
